The Gosset-Brabant Brut Tradition 1er Cru Champagne is captivating. Tiny bubbles surround a delicate array of dried apricots, pears and hazelnuts that finish in an elegant style with lovely structure and complexity.

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*Pol Roger Brut NV* \$25

Pale gold with very fine beads. Complex with notes of delicate white flowers, toasty aromas and fruit; creamy, beautifully balanced with a dry, harmonious finish.

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*La Caravelle Blanc de Blancs Brut NV* \$25

"A picture of elegance and finesse, this bubbly combines lemon, apple, mineral and a touch of honey with its lithe frame. It's all beautifully put together, with a crisp finish." —WINE SPECTATOR, 91 POINTS

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*Paul Goerg Brut Rosé NV* \$28

A fascinating salmon pink color, and elegantly light on the palate, this champagne has delicate yet dominant notes of young red fruits.

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*Sommariva Prosecco Superiore Brut Conegliano Valdobbiadene, Italy NV* \$12

From one of Italy's best prosecco making areas. A delicious citrus aroma and herb freshness with pleasant bread crust touches reach the palate together. Its fine bubbles enhances its bright straw-yellow color.

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*Lucien Albrecht Cremant d'Alsace Brut Rosé France NV* \$12

Made from 100% pinot noir, this cremant presents flavors of nice strawberry and wild cherry fruit, with a touch of richness on the mid palate. It is balanced with dry, crisp acidity and complimented with a creamy texture and long finish.

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*Bodegas Naverán "Dama" Cava Brut Spain 2011* \$14

Naverán Dama is a Cava masterpiece. A combination of Chardonnay, which gives the wine body and volume, and Parellada, which imparts a zesty, bright character that cuts through the buttery roundness of the Chardonnay.

*Rhône Blend, Donkey & Goat Sluice Box  
Sierra Foothills, California 2011* \$10

Pear skin, lemon thyme and chamomile on the nose. Gentle sweet orchard and pit fruit flavors with a refreshing note of bitter lemon pith.

WW-201

*Semi-Dry Riesling, Paumanok Vineyards  
North Fork of Long Island, New York 2011* \$12

Very German in style fresh and floral, exuding violets and tropical fruit aromas and flavors on an off-dry, focused structure. It exhibits uncanny lightness, lift and buffering out of its residual sugar, with orchard, tropical, black and citrus fruits backed by a shimmering expanse of wet slate.

201

*Aligote, Clendenen Family Vineyards  
Santa Maria Valley, California 2010* \$13

This elegant aligote is soft and fresh, well balanced with bright acidity and the prominent aromas of apples and lemons.

228

*Chardonnay, One Rock  
North Fork of Long Island, New York 2011* \$13

A dry wine with notes of mineral, apple, lemon and pineapple. Perfect as an aperitif, or with a wide range of light dishes.

275

*Chardonnay, Invictus  
Sonoma County, California 2012* \$15

This lemon-yellow Chardonnay is rich with pear, apple, and ripe citrus fruit blanketed with a creamy layer of toasted oak and spice.

234

*Chardonnay, Talley Vineyards  
Arroyo Grande, California 2011* \$18

Vibrant and fresh bouquet of lemon peel and lime zest with subtle creamy aromas. On the palate, this wine has layered flavors of citrus fruits and nuttiness that are blanced by a bright acidity leading into a long, elegant finish.

*Viognier Blend, Tablas Creek Cotes de Tablas Blanc  
Paso Robles, California 2011* \$20

Broad and rich, peaches and cream, but dry, with a very long finish with a hint of tannin, cream, and rocks, nicely saline at the end. A creamy oak finish, with just a touch of minerality.

WW-203

*Chardonnay, Presqu'île Winery  
Santa Maria Valley, California 2010* \$23

On the nose, fresh citrus and baked pears with hints of buttered toast and flowers. On the palate, a velvety texture and balanced acidity are supported by flavors of golden apple and honeysuckle which remain focused through the lengthy finish.

WW-204

*Pinot Gris, Robert Sinskey  
Carneros, California 2012* \$25

Stunningly beautiful to the eye with a gem-like glimmer, this whole cluster pressed rosé of Pinot Noir exhibits delicate purity. Aromas of pear and wild strawberry dance from the glass as complex flavors of mineral and herb co-mingle with a vibrant mouth-feel—an absolutely refreshing experience!

*Sauvignon Blanc, Merry Edwards  
Russian Rivery Valley, California 2012* \$28

The aroma is bursting with lychee fruit, fig and ripe pear. The finish is a creamy oak with just a touch of minerality.

WW-205

*Chardonnay, Chateau Montelena  
Napa Valley, California 2011* \$30

Rich golden straw color with clean pure aromas of pear and crisp green apple, all overlaid with light tropical fruit notes and a hint of honeysuckle. On the palate, this wine has wonderful fullness and creaminess without being heavy. A clean soft entry is quickly followed by crisp acidity and a rich display of fruit including juicy nectarine and white peach along with a hint of lychee and fresh citrus.

*Chardonnay, Kistler "Les Noisetiers"  
Sonoma Coast, California 2012* \$32

A pronounced and refined sense of minerality pierces through the initial first blush of stone fruit on the nose. Perfectly balanced, the core is packed with grilled citrus, a touch of lemongrass and threaded with a vibrant acidity that reverberates across the palate.

WW-206

*Sauvignon Blanc, Peter Michael "L'apres Midi"  
Knights Valley, California 2012* \$34

On the palate are notes of honeysuckle, white currant blossom, lily of the valley, lemon, lime, white peach, and goose-berry completed by touches of acacia honey and candied anise. Rich and zesty, the flavors are reminiscent of the aromas with additional fresh almond notes. The strong mineral background, a stamp of the estate, balances the overall richness, giving a superb refinement. The finish is layered, very long and elegant."

Intense and generous notes of citrus, pulpy white and exotic fruit, delicate honey and white flowers. Notes of white peach, lychee and kiwi fruit are also evident in the bouquet.

Floral notes lead to crushed rocks, limestone and lemon peel in this fabulous Chablis.

*Champalou Vouvray 2011* \$14

Dry and pure in style, with star fruit, pineapple, yellow apple skin and floral notes that stay well-defined through the open finish.

**290**

*Jean-Pierre et Pascal Lafond "Roc-Epine"  
Lirac, Rhône 2011* \$14

Fragrances of linden tree and white flowers, flavours of citrus fruit which evolves towards honey and acacia notes.

*Pascal et Nicolas Reverdy Cuvée Les Coutes  
Sancerre 2012* \$15

Full and opulent in structure, this Sauvignon Blanc presents natural ripeness and a low concentration of mineral.

*Robert Chevillon Bourgogne Aligote 2011* \$18

Very fresh apple notes, a floral bouquet of hawthorn and acacia with a soft hazelnut finish.

**272**

*Domaine Chantemerle Chablis 1er Cru  
Fourchaume 2011* \$20

Notes of light lavender, meyer lemon and orange rind. Beautifully round and crisp acidity backed with elegant minerality.

**WW-210**

*Weinbach Reserve Personelle Gewurtztraminer  
Alsace 2012* \$20

Sensational aromas of rose, lily, jasmine, spices, crystallized citrus.

**WW-211**

*Faiveley "Clos Rochette" Monopole  
Mercrey Blanc 2011* \$20

Delicate yet lively and round, this wine is very expressive with scents of white flowers and spices.

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*Kathausenhof Riesling Feinherb  
Mosel Germany 2011* \$18

A juicy, easy-to-drink wine. Mineralic depth, wonderful balance of sweetness and acidity.

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*Schloss Lieser Riesling Spatlese  
Niederberg Helden Mosel, Germany 2012* \$20

"Brilliantly clear, profound nose of peaches and apricots, but also of lemon. On the palate, delicate and playful, but with lots of power and complexity. Refreshing fruit flavors and an animating acidity in harmony with strength and a fine slate."

Wachau, Austria 2012* \$22

This is a clear brilliant lemon colored white wines with notes of peppery arugula and watercress on the nose, along with zesty lime, kumquats and wet slate. The palate has similar flavors of white grapefruit, peppery watercress and tangy clementine. This is a high quality wine with balance of acidity and long length.

### WW-223

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*Selbach-Oster Riesling "Anrecht"  
Zeltinger Himmelreich Mosel, Germany 2012* \$24

The wine presents with the subtlety and fragrance of flowers and the intense mineral quality from the slate soils as well as the the taste of delicate fruit and a lingering, crisp finish.

### WW-224

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*F.X. Pichler Grüner Veltliner Federspiel Loibner  
Frauenweingarten Wachau, Austria 2011* \$25

An exceptional Gruner from an ideal terroir. This wine is structured like lace, displaying clear quality delicate green fruit.

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*Trebbiano/Sauvignon Blanc, Giacomo Bianco  
Toscana 2010* \$10

A delicious everyday white, young and fresh and immensely appealing with a beautiful floral nose, a hint of lemon, good acidity and a soft round finish.

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*Vermentino, Santadi Villa Solais Sardegna 2010* \$11

Every once in a while you taste a wine that makes your nose twitch, it's so delicious. This Vermentino did this for us - so fresh and crisp, with notes of citrus peel and freshly cut grass.

245

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*Pinot Grigio, Vezzana Vigneti Delle Dolomiti  
Trentino-Alto Adige 2012* \$12

Ripe fruit aromas of apricot, peach and roasted almonds, fine acidity and a crisp finish.

260

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*White Blend, Terlano Terlaner Classico  
Trentino-Alto Adige 2012* \$14

Persistent notes of apricot, ripe tropical citrus fruits with a stream of intense minerality. Fresh fennel and bright acidity define the finish of this impeccably balanced wine.

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*Pinot Bianco, Villa Russiz Collio 2012* \$18

"...This wine gracefully balances a tropical expression of fruit and minerality in a polished, layered style that is undeniably appealing. It is the best of the estate's 2009's." —WINE ADVOCATE, 90 POINTS

*White Blend, Zyme Il Bianco "From Black To White"  
Veneto 2011* \$20

The wine presents with an expansive bouquet, with hints of citrus and herbs such as mint. On the palate, the wine is complex and full-bodied with notable viscosity, and an almost endless finish.

WW-226

*Pinot Grigio, St. Michael-Eppan  
Alto Adige 2011* \$25

Straw yellow in color with a nose of pears, apples, floral and mineral notes. It is medium-bodied with crisp acidity, good structure and rich flavors of apples, pears, peaches and citrus. The wine is well balanced, dry and smooth on the palate, and leaves a long, pleasing finish.

WW-227

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*Bianco Secco, Giuseppe Quintarelli, Ca'del Merlo  
Veneto 2012* \$30

An artful blend of Garganega, Trebbiano Toscano, Sauvignon Blanc, Chardonnay, and Saorin, a grape believed to be a clone of Tokay whose name translates to "flavor" in Veronese dialect. Debuting in 2004, Bianco Secco carries a bouquet of flowers, a brisk palate, and finishes with a touch of minerals and honey. Charming doesn't even begin to describe it.

## GLOBAL WHITES

### WW-228

*Sauvignon Blanc, Kato  
Marlborough, New Zealand 2013* \$10

Exhibiting zesty and aromatic notes of melon, passionfruit and citrus, Kato Sauvignon Blanc is well balanced, vibrant in flavor, persistent in finish and perfect for everyday enjoyment with seafood, pasta, white meats and salads.

### 257

*Torrontés, Crios de Susana Balbo  
Salta, Argentina 2012* \$11

Hints of peach pit, white pear, flowers and orange citrus fruit. Beautiful structure and acidity similar to Sauvignon Blanc.

### WW-229

*White Blend, Kir-Yianni Estate "Petra"  
Florina, Greece 2011* \$14

The wine is dry, fresh and crisp with moderate acidity. On the palate, peach, pear, mineral and lemon peel are the major elements. The flavors are savory, fresh and bright, with an almost pine-sap oily texture, and a slight bitter-almond finish with floral and mineral notes.

### 248

*Sauvignon Blanc, Cloudy Bay  
Marlborough, New Zealand 2013* \$18

Focused and pure, offering a tangy expression of balanced lemon, white peach, tangerine, passion fruit, melon and green tea notes. This is powerful in its persistence and juiciness, yet maintains an air of elegance.

### WW-330

*Chardonnay, Kumeu River Estate  
Kumeu, New Zealand 2009* \$20

Hints of hazelnut with a palate that shows ripe peach along with a crisp flinty character that gives the wine a refreshing cleansing quality.

### WW-331

*Chenin Blanc, DeMorgenzon Reserve  
Stellenbosch, South Africa 2012* \$23

This show stopping white displays effusive aromas of white flower, stone fruit, honey and toast which erupt into opulent flavours of pear, orange blossom, caramel and spice. It's a world class offering that strikes a brilliant balance between lush fruit and crisp, mouth watering acidity.

### WW-332

*White Blend, Quinta da Muradella "Alanda"  
Monterrei, Spain 2012* \$25

This wine has expressive, high pitched and fresh aromas of spring flowers, wet stones and minerals, with jasmine notes. On the palate, the fruit is clean, ripe and attractively tangy without being sweet and has a "nervy" acidity with a neat and clean finish.





## ROSÉ WINE

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*Cœur Estréle Côtes de Provence, France 2012*      **\$12**

This pink blend of Grenache, Carignan and Cinsault is extremely refreshing with full fruity flavors and good length - just the right wine to wash down seafood, salads and grilled fish.

**WW-333**

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*Château de Manissy Cuvée des Lys  
Tavel, France 2012*      **\$13**

Excellent richness paired with clean acidity with aromas and flavors of ripe cherries, crushed stone, rose petal and spice. Medium-bodied, rich and textured, with excellent length.

**238**

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*Collotte Marsannay, France 2012*      **\$14**

This is a rosé with class. Its pinot noir base lends it cherry and red fruit aromas and a dry, fresh finish.

**202**

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*Bastide Blanche Bandol, France 2012*      **\$16**

Weighty but delightful, this rosé is predominantly Mourvedre, with Grenache and Cinsault. Beautiful young berry notes, a sweet touch of cotton-candy, and a light stony finish.

Pure aromas and flavors of black cherries kissed by oak and complimented by just the right amount of Asian spice.

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*Cabernet Franc, Paumanok Vineyards  
North Fork of Long Island, New York 2012* \$13

Aromas of bramble fruit, herbs, flowers and spice. Medium-bodied with firm tannins, red fruit and cherry flavors.

367

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*Cabernet Sauvignon, One Rock  
North Coast, California 2010* \$15

Fresh aromas of cassis and cherry give way to a palate of vibrant dark fruit. Hints of oak and plush, silky tannins lead to a long, satisfying finish.

338

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*Merlot, Matanzas Creek  
Bennet Valley, Sonoma County 2010* \$15

Bright ruby red color, pronounced notes of plums, blueberries, black mulberries, vanilla, nutmeg and chocolate, toffee and dry oregano.

484

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*Syrah, Beckman Vineyards  
Santa Ynez Valley, California 2011* \$16

Aromas of plum, blackberry, cocoa, mesquite smoke, au jus and herb de Provence. On the palate are massive notes of chocolate, grilled meat and coffee flavors wrapped in lush fruit notes of plum, blackberry and huckleberry.

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*Pinot Noir, Maysara Jamsheed  
McMinnville, Oregon 2009* \$18

"Offers density, richness and depth without much weight, weaving earthy, spicy notes through the dark blueberry and plum flavors, lingering softly." —WINE SPECTATOR, 91 POINTS

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*Zinfandel Blend, Ridge Three Valleys  
Sonoma County, California 2011* \$18

Rich with bright but concentrated raspberry and black cherry, and a lovely spiciness and minerality that shows why Ridge sits high and proud as one of the best Zin producers in the country.

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*Cabernet Sauvignon, Invictus  
Napa Valley, California 2012* \$19

Made from fruit grown at a prestigious, first-growth-quality vineyard. Rich, smoky yet restrained nose with voluptuous richness in the mouth, balanced by fine minerality. A very elegant Cabernet.

371

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*Pinot Noir, Au Bon Climat "Merrywood"  
Santa Barbara County, California 2011* \$20

On the palate, there are very pure red fruit notes that intertwine beautifully with the perfumed spice and floral components. This wine possesses gorgeous balance, complexity and a persistent finish.

435

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*Zinfandel, Turley Old Vines  
Napa Valley, California 2011* \$20

"The 2011 Zinfandel Old Vines is a good introduction to the Turley house style. Sweet red berries, crushed flowers and licorice come together nicely in the glass. The 2011 offers lovely balanced to match its pretty, understated personality." —WINE SPECTATOR, 90 POINTS

359

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*Red Blend, Mark Herold Wines "Collide"  
Napa Valley, California 2009* \$20

"Provencal-like, it offers up notes of lavender, garrigue, pepper, roasted meats and black fruits in its rich, full-bodied personality. This consumer-friendly offering should drink well for a decade or more." —WINE ADVOCATE, 92 POINTS

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*Cabernet Sauvignon, Knollwood  
Napa Valley, California 2011* \$22

Made from rigorously selected grapes grown in the Valley, this well-structured and robust Cabernet echos plum and black currants which are persistent on the palate. Ripe tannins provide backbone to a lengthy finish.

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*Cabernet Sauvignon, Invictus Reserve*  
*Napa Valley, California 2008* \$24

Concentrated and robust, it's a wine of great finesse and class. This stylish Cabernet exhibits a deep purple color with a Medoc-like nuanced nose of cassis, Bing cherries and charcoal. It has a palate-coating texture, with chocolate, mineral and dark fruit on the back end.

**538**

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*Pinot Noir, Domaine Serene Oregon 2009* \$25

Domaine Serene makes a higher-end wine called Evenstad Reserve. In 2009 the climate did not yield a viable amount of grapes for that cuvee so the winery made this special bottling with that same Evenstad juice and a blend of other great Pinot Noir from Oregon.

**467**

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*Pinot Noir, Merry Edwards Sonoma Coast 2011* \$28

Fresh aromas of strawberry, raspberry and huckleberry are firm and spicy in this medium-bodied red, yet it gains depth and length, ending with a wet pebble and mineral edge.

**409**

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*Cabernet Sauvignon, Vineyard 29 "Cru"*  
*Napa Valley, California 2011* \$32

Aromas of dried red currant, ripe blackberries and milk chocolate give way to layers of fresh tobacco leaf, dried lavender and cedar. A generous palate offers roasted coffee, mocha, brambly black fruits and a touch of black pepper that slip seamlessly into a long supple finish.

**RW-101**

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*Pinot Noir, Paul Hobbs Russian River Valley,*  
*Sonoma County, California 2011* \$35

"Deep violet in color, this lush pinot noir carries expressive aromas of wild berries, rose petals and cola. The palate, silky and balanced, explodes with dark raspberry, plum, cloves and cocoa. Ripe currant and blackberry harmonize over a long, toasty finish supported by round tannins." —WINE ADVOCATE, 91 POINTS

**520**

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*Cabernet Sauvignon, Araujo Estate "Alianza"*  
*Napa Valley, California 2010* \$39

The 2010 is the first vintage of the famed winery's third wine- Alianza (Alliance in Spanish). An exceptional, beautiful and pleasurable cabernet sauvignon and a wonderful sibling to its elder wines- Eisele Vineyard and Altagracia.
